Job Overview: A Conductor will work with other members of the Operations department to service customers across the Reading and Northern system. A conductor will be part of a two-man train crew and will assemble and disassemble trains, make strategic moves with rail cars and interact with customers based on their needs.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Work with an Engineer to perform assigned daily tasks.
- Report to various locations on Railroad for work each day.
- Communicate with Customer Service department to understand customer needs.
- Throwing switches.
- Follow appropriate FRA and RBMN safety guidelines.
- Other duties as assigned and required.

Qualifications

- Ability to work around loud machines and equipment.
- Ability to work alone or in mixed groups.
- Ability to work in all kinds of weather conditions.
- Flexibility to work varying shifts and report out of any location across our system.
- Must be able to lift up to 70lbs.
- Ability to bend, stand, climb, kneel or sit for long periods.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
